Help your child with home reading

Please can you make sure that you hear your child read their school reading book 5 days each week. This needs to be recorded in their reading record book. At KS1 we ask parents and carers to fill out the comments, whereas in KS2, the children should be recording what they have read and writing a comment. Both reading books and reading record books need to be in school EVERY DAY!

Holidays

Government guidelines, which came into effect on 1st September 2013, prevent Headteachers from granting any leave of absence during term time purely for the reason of a family holiday.

If you feel you have an exceptional circumstance you must speak to the Headteacher prior to making any arrangements or taking any absence. In accordance with our Attendance Policy, please note that a family holiday is not an exceptional circumstance and will be subject to a prosecution.

Any unauthorised absence will be recorded on your child's attendance records. This may result in legal action as follows, a Penalty Notice to be issued to parents who commit such an offence in accordance with Section 444A of the Education Act. The penalty is £60 per parent, per child, if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid within 28 days. Failure to pay may result in prosecution where on conviction you would be liable to a fine of up to £1000.

Is your child eligible for Free School Meals - EBB?

Please register your child (including those in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) for free school meals if you are in receipt of qualifying benefits. Registration will attract additional funding for our school for Pupil Premium (£1,320 per Primary pupil). You can register your entitlement for Free School Meals - Eligible by Benefit (EBB) if you have children who attends a school in Bath and North East Somerset, and you are in receipt of any of the qualifying benefits listed below. Qualifying benefits for Free School Meals:

- · Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)
- · Income Support
- · Income Based Jobseekers Allowance
- · Income Related Employment and Support Allowance
- · Child Tax Credit, without any Working Tax Credit, and an annual household income (as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs) that is not more than £16,190
- · Run-on Working Tax Credit which is only paid for 4 weeks after you STOP qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- · Guaranteed Element of State Pension Credit

How to register – just call! Call the Free School Meals helpline on 01225 394317 to make a telephone registration. They will need you to tell them your National Insurance Number when you call. Please note that the Local Authority will check your eligibility to qualifying benefits on your behalf using the DFE online Free School Meal Eligibility Checking Service. Your National Insurance and Date of Birth must be accurate.
